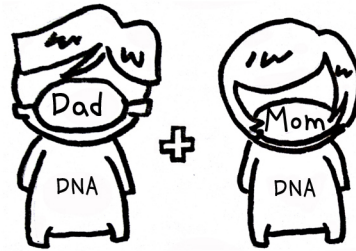

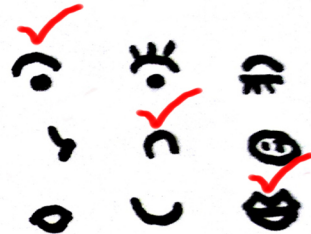


DNA is a substance

when we are born.



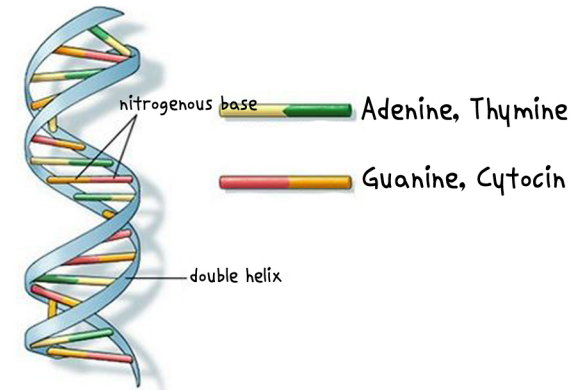
These DNAs have information for

DNA is consisted of two backbone and
nitrogenous base that connects those two.

There are four kinds of nitrogenous base –
adenine, guanine, thymine, and cytosine..



Adenine is only connected with thymine, and
guanine is always connected to cytocine.



These two backbones and nitrogenous
are connected to form
double-helix model of DNA.
